Dear Camper:

We are so glad that you will be able to attend Children's Camp Rockridge at Rockridge Baptist Assembly, 13200 GA Highway 100 in Franklin, Georgia 30217.

Mrs. Pam Murphy will be the Camp Director. Philip McClung will be the Camp Pastor. There will be varied activities, including Bible Study, swimming, recreation, inspirational services, and free time. The snack shop will be opened twice a day during camp. Items range from \$1.00 to \$2.00 each, so \$30.00 should be sufficient. Please send small bills, preferably ones.

Each camper who registers and pays by 1 pm on June 6 will receive a camp t-shirt. The cost of the T-shirt is included in the camp fee.

Please make plans and bring whatever you will need, including:

- 1. Bed linens (or sleeping bag) and pillow.
- 2. Personal articles, like toothbrush, soap, 2 towels, and washcloths.
- 3. Clothes, including play shorts, running/walking shoes, a modest swimsuit, and something warm in case the weather turns cool, along with a raincoat or rain poncho.
- 4. Your Bible, pencil, paper, and stamps if you wish to write home.
- 5. Closed-toe shoes are required. You may bring extra shoes or flip-flops, etc.
- 6. Sunscreen.
- 7. Please bring fishing gear (pole or rod/reel and <u>artificial bait</u>) if you plan to fish. Detach all fishhooks from the pole; hooks will be put on at camp. Only single hooks are allowed- no double or treble hooks, please.
- 8. Sorry, NO cell phones, video games, radios, or MP3 players are allowed in camp! No balls and bats or games.
- 9. Please do not bring snacks a snack shop is available. (Bring money for snacks)
- 10. Child's name should be on all belongings.

Campers should meet at First Baptist on the Square (Family Life Center) at 8:00 A.M. on Monday, June 17. Transportation to camp on Monday morning will be provided. Please bring all medication that your camper will need during the week along with completed Medication Permission Forms. Please DO NOT take your child to Rockridge!

All campers are to stay the entire time at camp, are not permitted off the grounds, and are expected to obey all camp rules. Should your child be responsible for damage to any camp property, you will be held financially responsible for any and all repairs.

Campers will pack up and be released to their parents or guardians during the time selected on the application: 4:00-4:30, 4:30-5:00, or 5:00-5:30 on Thursday afternoon at Camp Rockridge. **Please make arrangements for pick up at Camp Rockridge.**
